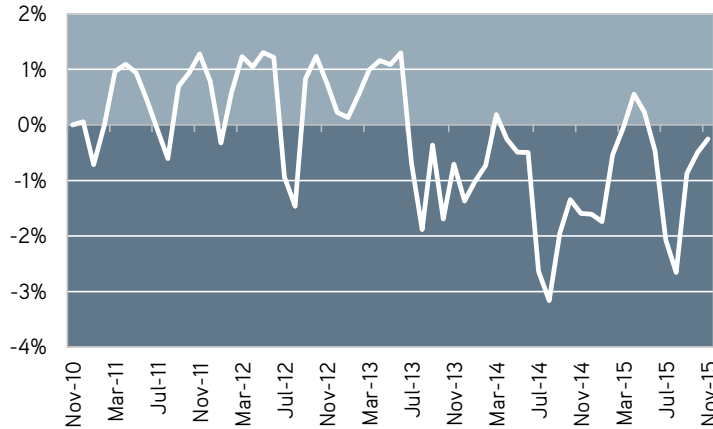

Cumberland Region



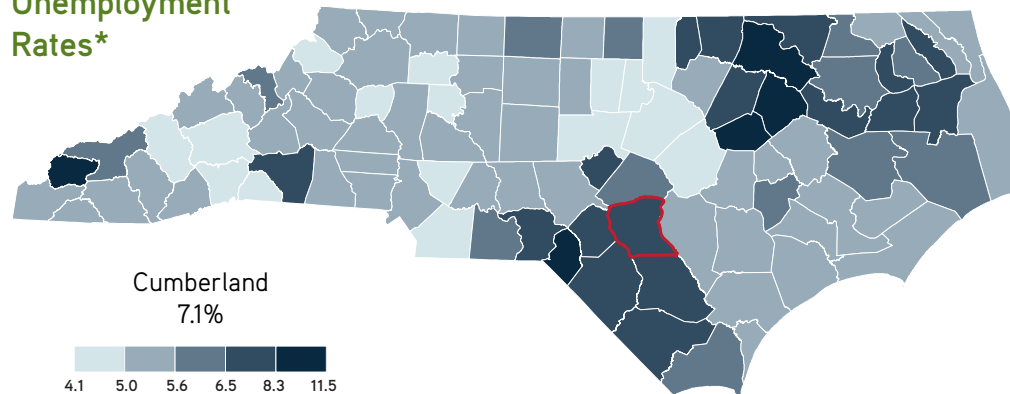
