# NIMS RESOLUTION

- Cumberland County Implemented the National Incident Management System (NIMS) on May 02, 2005
- Homeland Security Presidential Directive (HSPD)-5. The President directed the Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security to develop and administer a National Incident Management System (NIMS), which would provide a consistent nationwide approach for federal, state, local and tribal governments to work together more effectively & efficiently to prevent, prepare for, respond to, and recover from domestic incidents, regardless of cause, size, or complexity.
