Recovery Planning

- **A disaster recovery plan establishes the foundation to help a community return to pre-disaster conditions following a disaster.**
- **The driving factors behind such plans are public safety and economic recovery.**
- **Recovery planning is a phased approach that includes short- and long-term recovery.**
- **Recovery begins during the response phase, with the initial focus being on impact assessment.**

Organization of the Recovery Plan

- **Leadership**
 - **Steering Committee**
 - **Recovery Task Force**
 - Steering Committee
 - Primary Agency Leads
 - Others
- **Meets EMAP Standards**
- **Scalable for both short-term and long-term recovery**
- **Identifies Recovery Functions and references related ESFs**

Defining Recovery Functions

- **Support Function is based on concept established in the National Response Plan.**
- **It focuses on the categories of activities that will likely be completed following a disaster.**
- **These functions are very similar to those found in EOP which will allow orderly transition from response into recovery.**

Short-term Disaster Recovery Plan Objectives

Short-term

- **Coordinate utilities restoration**
- **Overseeing re-entry security operations**
- **Public Information and Planning**
- **Debris operations**
- **Assist with applicants briefing**
- **Support business industry in commercial reopening**
- **Implement continuity of government procedures**
- **Assist in communications of permitting**

Long-term Disaster Recovery Plan Objectives

- **Oversee reconstruction (Building Codes) and redevelopment**
- **Long-term recovery public information/community relations activities**
- **Environmental preservation and restoration**
- **Support of Business Assistance Centers until no longer needed - Help coordinate long-term recovery of business community**
- **Coordination of temporary housing operations (if needed)**
- **Oversee implementation of any Public Assistance (PA) projects**
