Cumberland County Public Library & Information Center Presents *Images from the Middle East*

Fayetteville—Chris Hondros, international photojournalist and native of Fayetteville, will present a fascinating lecture and presentation of his work as a journalist in Afghanistan and Pakistan.

Mr. Hondros has most recently been in Kabul and northern Iraq and will include photographs from his most recent project as well. The presentation will be on Tuesday, November 12 at 7:00 pm in the Pate Room of the Headquarters Library, 300 Maiden Lane, Fayetteville, N. C.

Based in New York City, Mr. Hondros received a Bachelor of Arts in English from North Carolina State in 1993, and is a Masters Degree in Visual Communications candidate at Ohio University. He first documented Kosovo in February 1999, and made two subsequent trips to the area after the NATO bombings had begun. Previously he worked as a staff photographer for newspapers in Ohio and North Carolina, and as a picture editor for the Associated Press. He has also worked in war-torn Angola.
