Heating Assistance Is Available for Eligible Families

FAYETTEVILLE - Cumberland County's Low Income Energy Assistance Program, administered by the Department of Social Services, provides eligible families a one-time cash payment to help pay heating bills. Applications will be taken between November 6 and 17, and payments will be made early in February. Call 677-2357 or 677-2441 for more information.
