## **Short Vaccine Supply Forces Health Department to Cancel Friday's H1N1 Clinic**

### **Thursday's Clinic Runs 3 to 5:30 p.m.**

FAYETTEVILLE – The Cumberland County Public Health Department, located at 227 Fountainhead Lane, will hold an H1N1 vaccination clinic **Thursday, Nov. 19, from 3 to 5:30 p.m.** in the department's auditorium located on the fourth floor. The vaccine will be available on a first-come, first-served basis.

**The department will not be able to hold an H1N1 vaccination clinic originally scheduled for Friday, Nov. 20, from 8 to 10:30 a.m. because it is running short on the vaccine.** As of today, the department has used almost all the vaccine allocated for schools this week and is having to divert some of its own allotment to the school vaccination program.

“We are dipping into our Health Department clinic vaccines to give to the school children on Thursday,” said Jane Stevens, a member of the Health Department's Leadership Team. “Therefore, we will have a limited amount of vaccine on Thursday, and Friday's clinic is canceled.”

The county is targeting pregnant women, people between the ages of 6 months and 24 years, people who live with children under 6 months old and those with underlying medical conditions.
