H1N1 Flu Clinics at Health Department and Elementary Schools

FAYETTEVILLE – The Cumberland County Public Health Department is hosting several H1N1 Flu Clinics this week.

The Health Department at 227 Fountainhead Lane will host clinics on Thursday, Nov. 12, from 3 p.m. to 7 p.m. and on Friday, Nov. 13, from 8 a.m. to 12 noon in the department's auditorium on the fourth floor.

There will be no out-of-pocket expense for the vaccine. An administrative cost will be billed to insurance providers. Everyone is asked to please bring a picture ID to the clinic.

The Health Department will also host an H1N1 Flu Clinic on Friday, Nov. 13, at the following Cumberland County Elementary schools for students: Baldwin, T. C. Berrien and Lillian Black. Only students whose have signed parental consent forms will receive the vaccine.

“The health department is working closely with public and private schools, daycares and the Partnership for Children to ensure that as many children as possible become vaccinated,” said Buck Wilson, Health Director.
