County Holds Public Meetings on Gray's Creek Water and Sewer District

FAYETTEVILLE – Cumberland County has scheduled two public meetings regarding the creation of a Gray's Creek Water and Sewer District in the southwest portion of the county.

The Board of Commissioners will hold a community meeting at 7 p.m. Oct. 5 at Gray's Creek Middle School, 5151 Celebration Dr. in Hope Mills.

The second meeting will be a public hearing at 6:45 p.m. Oct. 19 in Room 118 of the Cumberland County Courthouse, 117 Dick St.

Public Utilities Director Tom Cooney encourages area residents to attend the public meetings.

“This is an opportunity to learn more about the proposed district and have your questions answered,” he said. “The recently completed Cumberland County Rural Water Feasibility Study identified the Gray's Creek Water and Sewer District as a feasible project, and this will be the first step in moving forward with a county-wide water system.”

The official map and list of all parcels within the proposed Gray's Creek Water and Sewer District will be available at the meetings and are available for inspection during normal business hours at the county Public Utilities Office in Room 215 of the Historic County Courthouse, 130 Gillespie St.

The commissioners will hear all interested parties with respect to the proposed water and sewer district.
