Commissioners Call Special Meeting For Water Project Update

FAYETTEVILLE – The Cumberland County Board of Commissioners will be updated on several safe water projects, including the Gray's Creek Water and Sewer District, during a special meeting at 5 p.m. Monday, April 19 in Room 118 of the Courthouse. The commissioners will also consider scheduling a bond referendum for the Gray's Creek Community to finance a proposed water system.

In addition to the Gray's Creek Water and Sewer District, Public Utilities Director Tom Cooney will brief the board on the following water projects: Bragg Estates, Overhills Park, Brooklyn Circle, Cedar Creek Road Water Line Extension, and Southpoint.

Cooney's presentation will mainly focus on the Gray's Creek project. He will highlight the costs, benefits, and liabilities of various proposals for providing district wide water in the Gray's Creek Water and Sewer District. He will also present options available for getting water service to the Southpoint community, located in Gray's Creek.

The meeting will be televised live on Time Warner Cable's Channel 7, the Community Channel. The commissioners' regular meeting is scheduled to follow at 6:45 p.m.
