Grant Money for Military Spouses

FAYETTEVILLE, NC – The Cumberland County Workforce Development Center still has **Spring Term II** grant money available for spouses of active-duty military personnel stationed at Fort Bragg or Pope Air Force Base. **Spring Term II will start in March 2011**. Director Geneva Mixon encourages eligible military spouses to apply for the Workforce Development Center's Career Advancement Account grants.

Military spouses who meet the grant requirements can receive up to \$6,000 for expenses such as tuition, fees, books and supplies directly related to post-secondary education and training. This grant program can assist individuals with obtaining associate's or bachelor's degrees, as well as paying for credentialing or licensing fees.

Approved career fields are health care, education, financial services, information technology, hospitality, human resources, business administration, homeland security, social work, paralegal studies and construction.
