County Seeks Public Input for Hazard Mitigation Plan

FAYETTEVILLE - Cumberland County and its municipalities (Eastover, Fayetteville, Falcon, Godwin, Hope Mills, Linden, Spring Lake, Stedman, and Wade) will soon start updating the “Cumberland County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan.” The update, which will be the blueprint for reducing property damage and saving lives from the effects of future natural disasters, is required in order for Cumberland County and its municipalities to be eligible to receive certain types of state and federal disaster relief funds after a disaster occurs.

There will be a drop-in session concerning the update on July 1 from 1 p.m. to 7 p.m. in Hearing Room #3 of the Historic Courthouse at 130 Gillespie St. Staff will be available to solicit input and answer any questions or concerns regarding the plan.

A copy of the original “Cumberland County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan” is available for review at all municipal Town Halls; the County Commissioners’ office; and the City of Fayetteville and Cumberland County planning departments.
