Raeford Road Recommendations Revealed at June 22 Public Information Session

FAYETTEVILLE - The public is invited to an information session on June 22 regarding the Raeford Road Corridor Study recently conducted by the Fayetteville Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (FAMPO) and consulting firm Kimley-Horn. Transportation planners will present the study's findings and recommendations during the meeting, which starts at 6 p.m. at 71st High School, 6764 Raeford Rd.

The recommendations are the direct result of ideas presented by the public to planners and engineers during a March workshop about the Raeford Road corridor, one of Fayetteville's most congested. Planners are seeking feedback from citizens and will hold a question-and-answer session. Refreshments will be served.

"Come out and see how your community is working to balance safety, traffic congestion and sustainable growth along the Raeford Road corridor," said Mike Rutan, a FAMPO planner.

The Raeford Road corridor study area runs between Robeson Street on the eastern edge and Hampton Oaks Drive on the west end.

Along with identifying strategies to improve mobility, the study will examine the underlying causes of the high crash rate and identify efficient and effective safety improvements and ways to reduce congestion.
