Commissioners Host Ethics Training Webinar Thursday for Local Elected Officials

FAYETTEVILLE – The Cumberland County Board of Commissioners will convene a special meeting at 4 p.m. Thursday, March 25, in the Crown Coliseum’s Hospitality Room for an ethics training session now required by state law.

In 2009 the North Carolina General Assembly passed legislation that requires local governing boards to adopt a code of ethics and requires board members to receive ethics training. The University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill School of Government is offering the two-hour webinar on Thursday as a way for elected officials to fulfill the legal requirement for two clock hours of ethics training by January 1, 2011.

The Board of Commissioners, which has paid the \$95 per site registration fee for the course, has invited governing board members from the county’s municipalities, the Board of Education and the Eastover Sanitary District to attend. Chairman Billy King also extended an invitation to the county’s department heads.
