Bragg and Pope Military Spouses Eligible for Career Advancement Grants

FAYETTEVILLE – Spouses of active-duty military personnel stationed at Fort Bragg and Pope Air Force Base are encouraged to apply for Career Advancement Account grants through the Cumberland County Workforce Development Center.

Military spouses who meet the grant requirements can receive up to \$6,000 for expenses such as tuition, fees, books and supplies directly related to post-secondary education and training. This grant program can assist individuals with obtaining associate's or bachelor's degrees, as well as paying for credentialing or licensing fees.

This is a great opportunity to develop a mobile career that is transferrable worldwide. Approved career fields are health care, education, financial services, information technology, hospitality, human resources, business administration, homeland security, social work, paralegal studies and construction.
