Commissioners to Hold Public Hearing on Gray's Creek Water and Sewer Bond Order

FAYETTEVILLE – The Cumberland County Board of Commissioners, acting as the Gray's Creek Water and Sewer District governing board, will hold a public hearing Nov. 15 on the issuance of \$21 million in bonds to finance the acquisition, construction and installation of a public water system for the district.

The public hearing on the bond order will take place during the board's regular meeting, which starts at 6:45 p.m. in Room 118 of the Cumberland County Courthouse. It will be televised live on Time Warner's Community Channel 7.

The bond order would not take effect until approved by voters in the district during a referendum on March 15. In September, the board gave preliminary approval for a special bond referendum not to exceed \$21 million. The bond would be for 40 years.

In other agenda items, the commissioners will consider a recommendation from the Facilities Committee to hire Mosely Architects for the Detention Center expansion project. They will also consider funding a local call center for the Child Support Department and adopting a code of ethics. The board is also slated to nominate an individual to fill a vacancy on the Social Services Board.
