The Answer Book: A Key Resource to Community Organizations *Users may now print lists of requested agency information*

FAYETTEVILLE, NC – A valuable community resource developed by the Cumberland County Public Library & Information Center, *The Answer Book*, is now easier than ever to access and tailor to individual needs thanks to a recent upgrade to its software application.

The directory's 1,623 subject headings describe 979 agencies that are providers in the area of human services, nonprofits, governmental organizations and clubs. Users can now create, edit and print a customized list of resources; an online tutorial helps explain the process.

The Answer Book is accessible through the library's Website at www.cumberland.lib.nc.us and can be searched by name of organization or by subject. When search results come up, simply click on the green plus sign next to the agency names to create a list. From there, the list is editable and printable and may be saved as a document.

Over the years, this resource has provided valuable information for longtime residents and newcomers alike. No guide to community resources can be totally up-to-date or complete, as changes occur continuously. The information in this directory is current and accurate as of press time.
