Access to Residential Areas

At this time, the requirement for a resident of the tornado-devastated areas to have an **ID Access Pass** issued by the Fayetteville Police Department has been lifted. Residents will be allowed to enter into the affected areas without restriction. Also, contractors will no longer have to obtain a **Contractor Authorization Form** issued from the City of Fayetteville Inspections Department.

However, the curfew that was enacted following the declaration of a State of Emergency on April 16, 2011 will now remain in affect until Monday April 25, 2011 at 6:00 am. The curfew will be in affect from 9:00 pm until 6:00 am each day in the devastated areas that have been previously identified, which include the following subdivisions:

- Lagrange
- Summerhill
- Cottonade
- College Lakes
- Stonegate
- Fairfield Farms
- Summerchase
