Request to Rezone 611-Acre Roslin Farms Road Site Withdrawn

FAYETTEVILLE, NC – The request to rezone 611 acres of land located on Roslin Farm Road has been withdrawn by the landowner and the Fayetteville-Cumberland County Chamber of Commerce. The rezoning case was No. P11-61, to rezone 611 acres from A1 Agricultural to M(P) Planned Industrial, or to a more restrictive zoning district; located on the northeast side of Roslin Farm Road (State Road 2243) and southwest of Braxton Road (State Road 2242).

Fayetteville-Cumberland County Chamber of Commerce President Doug Peters emailed Cumberland County Planning Department Director Tom Lloyd this afternoon and requested to withdraw the application to rezone the 611 acres of land. The original application to rezone was made by P.R. Barker Jr., the land owner, and the Chamber of Commerce.

As a result of the withdrawn request, the public hearing previously scheduled for Case No. P11-61 will not be held at the Jan. 3 regular meeting of the Cumberland County Board of Commissioners.

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
