## Taxpayers Reminded of Deadline, Office Closings

FAYETTEVILLE, N.C. – An important deadline is approaching for taxpayers. The Cumberland County Tax Administration Office reminds citizens that 2011 property taxes for real estate and personal property listed in January 2011 will be delinquent if not paid by **Thursday, Jan. 5, 2012**. Interest will be added if the deadline is missed.

To pay in person, go to Room 527 on the fifth floor of the Cumberland County Courthouse, Monday through Friday, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

County Government offices and the Courthouse will be closed on **Monday and Tuesday, Dec. 26-27** for the Christmas holiday and on **Monday, Jan. 2** for the New Year's holiday.

The Tax Office wants the public to be forewarned about these closings and to plan appropriately. The last week of the year is extremely busy for the office with people wanting to pay their taxes in time for the 2011 income tax deduction.

Tax payments can be mailed to Cumberland County Tax Collector, PO Box 449, Fayetteville, NC, 28302. Payments must be postmarked by the U.S. Postal Service by Jan. 5, 2012, to avoid interest.

Payments can be made in the office, by phone, or online with your Visa, MasterCard, American Express, or Discover credit or debit card. There is a processing fee for credit/ debit card payments whether made in the office, by calling 1-866-441-6614 or online at [www.co.cumberland.nc.us/tax/payments/](http://www.co.cumberland.nc.us/tax/payments/).

Electronic check draft payments may be made online for no additional fee.
