## Summer Session Grants Available for Fort Bragg Active-Duty Spouses

FAYETTEVILLE, NC – Summer-term tuition assistance is available for eligible spouses of active-duty military personnel stationed at Fort Bragg and Pope Army Air Field. The Cumberland County Workforce Development Center's Career Advancement Account program will be conducting information sessions starting March 29 at the Spring Lake Workforce Development Center, 103 Laketree Blvd.

Military spouses who meet the grant requirements can receive funding for the 2011 summer term to assist with tuition, fees, books and supplies directly related to post-secondary education and training, including credentialing or licensing fees. Funding will not be available after September 30.

Approved career fields are health care, education, financial services, information technology, hospitality, human resources, business administration, homeland security, social work, paralegal studies and construction.
