County to Waive Fees for Electrical Inspections, Wood Debris for an Additional Two Weeks

FAYETTEVILLE – Cumberland County has extended fee waivers for electrical inspections in storm-affected areas for an additional two weeks, until May 13. Residents in need of electrical inspections to their homes or businesses should call the Cumberland County Planning and Inspections Department at 678-7600.

Additionally, any residents with trees shorter than nine feet in length and other yard waste may dispose of them at the Wilkes Road Treatment & Processing (T&P) Facility free of charge until May 13. This facility accepts small tree limbs and stumps.

The Wilkes Road Treatment & Processing Facility is open Monday through Saturday, 8 a.m. until 4 p.m. For more information on dumping wood debris at the landfill, please call 486-0839.
