Disaster Recovery Center Closing May 26

The Disaster Recovery Center located at the Cumberland County Department of Social Services, 1225 Ramsey St., will permanently close at 5 p.m. on Thursday, May 26. The center opens at 8 a.m. and will remain open until 7 p.m. today through Wednesday. It will close two hours earlier on Thursday.

Following the close of the Disaster Recovery Center, storm victims may continue to call (800) 621-3362 to register for disaster assistance, check application status and update contact or insurance company information. Callers with speech or hearing disabilities can call (TTY) (800) 462-7585.

Affected residents also can register online at www.DisasterAssistance.gov, or on their smartphone at <http://m.fema.gov>. The final day to register with FEMA is June 20.
