Senior Community Service Employment Program Moves to Spring Lake Office

FAYETTEVILLE, NC – The Cumberland County Senior Community Services Employment Program (SCSEP) has moved to the Spring Lake Family Resource Center at 103 Laketree Blvd. It was previously located at 410 Ray Ave. in Fayetteville.

The program provides part-time employment opportunities in non-profit and governmental agencies for unemployed, low-income individuals ages 55 and older. It currently serves seniors in Cumberland, Robeson, Moore, Lee, Richmond and Bladen County.
