Gray's Creek Water System Bond Referendum

Community Meeting Scheduled for Thursday Night

Voters in the Gray's Creek Water and Sewer District will decide in the Nov. 8 election whether or not to pass a \$21 million bond referendum to construct a district water system.

District residents can learn more about the proposed water system project at 7 p.m. on Thursday, Oct. 13, at Gray's Creek Fire Department #18, 7010 Fire Department Rd., Hope Mills.

Another meeting is scheduled for 7 p.m. on Oct. 27 at Gray's Creek Elementary School, 2964 School Rd., Hope Mills.

There you will find links to the Water Use Ordinance, answers to frequently asked questions, a listing of streets for the projected phases, a map of the district, and the Rural Water Feasibility Study conducted in 2009.
