One-Stop Early Voting Starts Thursday, Sept. 22

FAYETTEVILLE, N.C. One-stop early voting for the Oct. 11 Fayetteville municipal primary election begins Thursday, Sept. 22, at the Board of Elections office, which is located at 301 East Russell St. Hours are Monday through Friday 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Early voting ends on Saturday, Oct. 8. Hours that day will be 8 a.m. to 1 p.m.

The contests running in the primary are: Fayetteville Mayor and Fayetteville City Council Districts 1, 4 and 6.

The general election will be Nov. 8 for all municipalities, the Eastover Sanitary District and the Gray's Creek Water & Sewer District bond referendum.
