County Names Engineering and Infrastructure Director

FAYETTEVILLE, NC – County Manager James Martin has named Jeffery Brown as the new Director of Engineering and Infrastructure. Brown replaces County Engineer Robert Stanger, who retires May 1 after 30 years with the county. Brown's first day will be April 30.

Brown's professional experience includes eight years with the City of Fayetteville, where he worked his way up from Engineer II, to City Engineer, and then the Engineering and Infrastructure Director. Prior to joining the city's engineering department, he spent five years with the NC Department of Environment and Natural Resources as an environmental engineer.

Brown graduated from Midway High School in Dunn. He is a 1997 graduate of NC State University, where he earned a bachelor's of science degree in biological and agricultural engineering.
