Board of Elections Closes Early Friday, Moves to New Home

FAYETTEVILLE – The Board of Elections office at 301 East Russell St. will close at noon on Friday, Aug. 24. The office will open at 8 a.m. on Monday, Aug. 27, at its new location in the E. Newton Smith Center at 227 Fountainhead Lane in Fayetteville

The elections office is moving into larger quarters on the first floor of the county's former public health center. The phone number for the elections office will remain the same, 910-678-7733. Office hours are 8 a.m.-5 p.m. weekdays.

In addition to the Board of Elections office, voter registration forms are available at all Cumberland County public libraries; the Department of Motor Vehicles; Department of Social Services, Employment Security Commission, Armed Forces Recruitment offices and various other agencies.

The E. Newton Smith Center was home to the Department of Public Health until January 2010 when the new Public Health Center opened on Ramsey Street. The Smith Center's entrance faces Fountainhead Lane, which is accessible from Hay and McGilvary Streets.

The E. Newton Smith Center is also home to the county's Employee Health Services, which includes an in-house pharmacy, express-care clinic and wellness program that serve employees and county government retirees. Employee Health Services is an initiative designed to improve the health of county employees and reduce the costs paid out-of-pocket by both employees and the county for medical office visits and pharmacy bills.
