FAYETTEVILLE, NC – Area subcontractors and suppliers will have a chance to learn more about Cumberland County's \$15 million Detention Center expansion project on March 29 during a 6 p.m. information session at the Headquarters Library at 300 Maiden Lane in downtown Fayetteville.

Balfour Beatty-Metcon, BJL Construction Company and Cumberland County will host the meeting and invite local Minority and Women Business Enterprise companies and other subcontractors to attend and learn how they can become a part of the project. The agenda will cover the project schedule, contracting opportunities and introductions to the construction managers.
