Animal Shelter Fees Increase Effective May 1

FAYETTEVILLE, NC – Cumberland County Animal Control has raised shelter fees for animals reclaimed by their owners. Effective May 1, the fee increased from \$7 per day of impoundment to \$30 for the first day and \$10 per day thereafter of impoundment.

The fees were increased to help Animal Control recoup some of the increased cost in maintaining the shelter and providing vaccines and medications during the first day of impoundment. Animals that come into the shelter without vaccination documentation are dewormed and receive the distemper, parvo and bordatella vaccines.
