Southwest Cumberland Land Use Plan

Community Meetings Scheduled for Nov. 27 and Nov. 29

HOPE MILLS, NC – The Cumberland County Planning Department will present the draft of the Southwest Cumberland Detailed Land Use Plan at two community meetings in November. The department has been working with the Southwest Citizen's Planning Committee in developing the plan.

Area residents are invited to learn more about the plan on Tuesday, Nov. 27, at 7 p.m. at Elizabeth Cashwell Elementary School, 2970 Legion Rd.

Another meeting will be held Thursday, Nov. 29, at 7 p.m. at the Hope Mills Recreation Center, 5766 Rockfish Rd.

The Study Area, which includes the Town of Hope Mills, has the following borders: Business 95 (U.S. 301 South) to the east; Hoke County line to the west; Robeson County line to the south; and Cumberland Road, at the Fayetteville City limits, to the north.

In addition to the community meetings, maps of the proposed plan are available for public viewing at the Hope Mills Recreation Center, Hope Mills Town Hall, Stoney Point Recreation Center and the Cumberland County Planning Department in the Historic Courthouse at 130 Gillespie St.
