Cedar Creek Connector Service Starts Oct. 15

FAYETTEVILLE - Cumberland County's Community Transportation Program will offer a connector van service in the Cedar Creek area starting Monday, Oct. 15. County commissioners approved the three-month pilot project in September.

The Cedar Creek Connector Service will run Monday through Friday between the Cedar Creek Baptist Church at 4170 Tabor Church Road and the Fayetteville Area System of Transit (FAST) Transfer Center at 147 Old Wilmington Rd. The fare is \$1 for one-way and must be paid in exact change.

There will be two morning pick-ups at Cedar Creek Baptist Church at 5 a.m. and 6 a.m., with arrival at the transfer station at 5:30 a.m. and 6:30 a.m. respectively. Service resumes in the evenings with the van departing from the transfer station at 6 p.m. and 7 p.m. for the trip to Cedar Creek.

Key points for Cedar Creek Connector Service:

- Service will be provided on a first-come, first-serve basis. The van can carry 14 passengers.
- \$1 one-way fare should be paid in exact change.
- No smoking, eating, or drinking is allowed on the van.
- For the safety of all riders, bags (groceries) are allowed on the van as long as passengers can carry them and place them in their laps, without taking up space for other passengers.
- Riders under the age of 8 and 80 pounds must have a proper car seat/booster seat to ride the service.
- Service will not be provided on Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, or New Year's Day.
