One-Stop Early Voting Ends Saturday, Polls Open 6:30 a.m.-7:30 p.m. on Election Day

FAYETTEVILLE – The Cumberland County Board of Elections reminds voters that one-stop early voting ends Saturday, Nov. 3. The eight early voting sites will not be open on Sunday.

Citizens can vote Saturday until 1 p.m. at E.E. Miller Recreation Center, East Regional Branch Library, Smith Recreation Center and Spring Lake Branch Library. The following four sites will be open Saturday until 5 p.m.: the Board of Elections office in the county's former public health center at 227 Fountainhead Lane, Cliffdale Recreation Center, Hope Mills Recreation Center and North Regional Branch Library.

Terri Robertson, the director of Cumberland County Board of Elections, also reminds citizens that you must already be registered in order to vote on Election Day, Nov. 6, which means Saturday is the last chance for individuals who wish to register and vote as part of the one-stop process.

On Tuesday, all 77 polling sites will open at 6:30 a.m. and close at 7:30 p.m. Approximately 570 poll workers have been hired to staff the precincts on Election Day, Robertson said.
