Public Hearing Dec. 16 on Bragg Estates Water & Sewer District

FAYETTEVILLE – The Cumberland County Board of Commissioners will hold a public hearing at 6:45 p.m. Dec. 16 in Room 118 of the Courthouse at 117 Dick Street to consider creating a water and sewer district for the Bragg Estates area in the northwestern corner of Cumberland County along Vass Road.

If approved, the Bragg Estates Water and Sewer District would include 173 properties on the following streets: 1003 to 1246 block of Vass Road, Riverside Circle, Kenwood Avenue and Dolphin Drive.

Following the public hearing, the Board of Commissioners will consider adopting the resolution to create the Bragg Estates Water and Sewer District for the purpose of applying for grant and low interest rate loans from the U.S. Department of Agriculture and the Clean Water State Revolving Fund to provide sewer service to the district.

The Board of Commissioners invites all interested parties to sign up to speak by calling 678-7771 or 678-7772 or by registering the night of Dec. 16 with the Clerk to the Board prior to the start of the meeting.

“The Bragg Estates community has been experiencing septic tank failures over the last several years. These failures pose health and safety concerns for the community,” said Jeffery Brown, Cumberland County Engineering and Infrastructure Director.

The official map and list of all parcels within the proposed Bragg Estates Water and Sewer District are available for inspection during normal business hours at the county’s Public Utilities Office, Room 214 of the Historic Courthouse at 130 Gillespie St. The information is also available online at www.co.cumberland.nc.us/public_utility/bragg_estates.aspx.

The Board of Commissioners meeting will air live on Fayetteville-Cumberland Educational TV, Time Warner Channel 5 and 97.3. It will be rebroadcast on Dec. 17 at 7:30 p.m.
