Professions represented include: education, banking, manufacturing, sales, law enforcement, information technology and more. The following programs are offered in conjunction with the job fair:

- Career Readiness Certificate Training: 10 a.m. – 1 p.m.
Gives individuals a step ahead of the competition by demonstrating to employers that the certificate holder has three basic skills needed for most jobs: applied mathematics, reading for information, and locating information. Certification is at either the gold, silver or bronze levels based on exam scores.
- Job Searching with PipelineNC: 10 a.m. – noon
Learn how this website helps with finding employment, locating educational opportunities and planning a career.
- Resume and Interviewing Tips: 10 a.m. – 2 p.m.
Members of the Fayetteville Area Society of Human Resource Managers offer a program every hour on the hour for interviewing tips and dressing for success. They will review resumes, applying their professional standards every hour on the half hour.
- Work on Your Resume: 10 a.m. – 2 p.m.
