
Cumberland County Register J. Lee Warren Jr. Receives State Awards

FAYETTEVILLE – At the recent 61st annual conference of the North Carolina Registers of Deeds Association, J. Lee Warren, Jr. of Cumberland County received the association's Eunice Ayers Award, which is named for the association's first president elected in 1952. It is the most prestigious award given by the association and is voted on by all of the members.

In addition, Warren also received the Outstanding Register of Deeds Award presented by the North Carolina Association of County Commissioners, an affiliate organization to NCARD. Warren served as a county commissioner, including three terms as the chairman of the board, from 1992 until May 2003 when he was appointed to the office of Cumberland County Register of Deeds. He was elected Register of Deeds in 2004 and re-elected in 2008 and 2012.

The NCARD is comprised of Registers of Deeds from throughout the state, working closely in collaboration to increase effectiveness as public servants. Warren has been busy this year attending district meetings, working with the UNC School of Government, as well as visiting all 100 county Register of Deeds offices across the state.
