April County Programs Available for Viewing

FAYETTEVILLE – The April 2014 episodes of “Cumberland Matters” and “Cumberland Conversations” are available for viewing on television and online. The programs are posted on the county’s YouTube page at www.youtube.com/CumberlandCountyNC and on Fayetteville/Cumberland Educational TV (FCETV), Time Warner Cable Channel 5 and 97-3 on the digital tier.

On “Cumberland Conversations,” Board of Elections Director Terri Robertson and Bill Helms discuss the workings of the county’s Board of Elections. One-stop voting begins April 24 for the May 6 primary.

The April episode of “Cumberland Matters” features the following segments:

- *At Your Library* – Cumberland County Public Library and Information Center Youth Services Librarian Sheila Rider explains how the N.C. Science Festival, hosted by the library, encourages learning through science, technology, engineering and math activities.
- *Cumberland Cares* – Cumberland County Solid Waste Recycling Coordinator Janice Daniel explains how the county uses innovative techniques to recycle everything from concrete to shingles and household waste.
- *Extension Today* – Cooperative Extension Agent Colby Lambert highlights ways motorists can share the roads with farm equipment as the spring planting season brings increased encounters between traffic and tractors on the highways.
- *News and Information* – Animal Control Director Dr. John Lauby promotes the rabies vaccination clinics being held throughout the county in April and explains the importance of protecting your pet and family.
- *Public Safety* – Cumberland County Emergency Services Program Coordinator Gene Booth gives advice on ways citizens can be alert and stay prepared for weather emergencies.
