Board of Elections Reminds Citizens of Voting Deadlines

FAYETTEVILLE – The Cumberland County Board of Elections reminds citizens of the deadlines for participating in the Nov. 4 general election. There have been changes regarding One-Stop Voting and registration during the early voting period due to new state laws.

The deadline to register for the November election or to make changes to current registrations is **Oct. 10**.

One-Stop Voting begins **Oct. 23**. A Cumberland County resident who is qualified to vote and is registered to vote in Cumberland County 25 days prior to the election may vote during the One-Stop Voting period. The One-Stop Voting period extends from the second Thursday before an election and not later than 1 p.m. on the last Saturday before the election. Voter registration is not conducted during the One-Stop Voting period.

Registered voters may update their address and change vital information in an existing registration record at the One Stop Site.

Important deadlines are listed below:

Sept. 5	Absentee ballot by mail begins
Oct. 23	One-Stop Voting begins
Oct. 28	Last day to apply for absentee ballot by mail
Nov. 1	One-Stop Voting ends at 1 p.m.
Nov. 3	Last day to receive absentee ballots by mail
Nov. 4	Last day for the Board of Elections to receive hand-delivered absentee ballots (5 p.m.)
Nov. 4	General Election
