Bullard Circle Water Project Public Hearing Aug. 18

FAYETTEVILLE – A public hearing on the Bullard Circle Water Extension Project is scheduled during the regular Cumberland County Board of Commissioners meeting Aug. 18 at 6:45 p.m. The meeting will be in Room 118 of the Courthouse, 117 Dick St.

The project was initiated after testing revealed arsenic levels in 22 individual groundwater wells exceeded federal standards for drinking water. The project will install 5,414 linear feet of water mains to serve 76 parcels within the Bullard Circle area. Property owners will share 50 percent of the project cost while Cumberland County and Public Works Commission will pay the remaining 50 percent. The terms of payment by property owners will be 15 annual installments at an interest rate of 6 percent.
