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Health Department Announces Computerized Registration System For WIC Program

FAYETTEVILLE – The Cumberland County Department of Public Health’s Women, Infant, Children (WIC) Program successfully implemented the new Crossroads computerized registration system for WIC applicants. The system launched in Cumberland County in July and resulted in shorter wait times, more quality nutrition education and faster appointment scheduling and re-scheduling.

The WIC Program provides healthy foods at no cost to new and breastfeeding mothers, infants and children under 5 whose income meets the requirements and who are at a medical or nutrition risk. Cumberland County has three WIC offices:
