Meetings are also broadcast live on Fayetteville/Cumberland Educational Television (FCETV) Time Warner Cable Channel 5 and 97-3 on the digital tier. They are rebroadcast the following Tuesday at 7:30 p.m.

The commissioners will meet Monday, Feb. 3, at 9 a.m. in Room 118 of the Cumberland County Courthouse.

Following Monday’s meeting, the commissioners will dedicate the county’s new Detention Center expansion during an 11 a.m. ceremony inside the new addition at 204 Gillespie St. Law enforcement, court system representatives, elected officials and the public are invited to the event. Sheriff’s deputies will direct attendees to the designated parking area and expansion entrance off Worth Street.

Construction started in September 2012 on the \$15 million project that will add 316 beds to the 568 in the existing Detention Center, which opened in 2003.
