FAYETTEVILLE – The January 2014 episodes of “Cumberland Matters” and “Cumberland Conversations” are available for viewing on television and online. “Cumberland Matters” features five segments spotlighting various county government programs, services and upcoming events. “Cumberland Conversations” is a 30-minute talk-show format program featuring in-depth interviews with subject-matter experts.

The episode of “Cumberland Matters” currently airing features the following segments:

- At Your Library – Cumberland County Public Library and Information Center Deputy Director Brian Manning explains how the N.C. Cardinal system will expand and enhance library services.
- Extension Today – The Cumberland County Agricultural Hall of Fame’s latest inductees, retired soil conservationist Julian McIntyre and former Cooperative Extension Director George Autry discuss their long careers and their induction into the Hall of Fame.
- Cumberland Cares – Lynn Pippin of the Department of Social Services talks about how the Low Income Energy Assistance Program (LIEAP) and the Crisis Intervention Program (CIP) help families with energy costs so they can stay warm in the winter and cool in the summer.
- News and Information – Will Denning of Cumberland County Planning and Inspections talks about the Southwest Cumberland Land Use Plan.
