FAYETTEVILLE – Job seekers are invited to the annual “March to Work” Job Fair on March 27 from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. at the Crown Expo Center, 1960 Coliseum Dr.

The Cumberland County Department of Social Services is partnering with Beasley Broadcast Group, the City of Fayetteville Community Development, Cumberland County Public Library and Information Center, Fayetteville Technical Community College, Hardee’s and the Public Works Commission to present the job fair.
