Republican and Unaffiliated Poll Workers Needed

FAYETTEVILLE – The Board of Elections still needs unaffiliated and registered Republican poll workers for the county's 77 voter precincts during the Nov. 4 General Election.

You must be a registered voter to work the polls and must attend a training session, which lasts about five hours. Poll workers are paid for attending training prior to the election and working on Election Day from 5:30 a.m. until all precincts have closed.
