Solid Waste Can Help Citizens Properly Dispose Of Yard Waste

FAYETTEVILLE – Cumberland County Solid Waste Management can help citizens properly dispose of yard debris at the Wilkes Road Treatment and Processing Facility.

The Wilkes Road Treatment and Processing Facility, located at 771 Wilkes Rd., Fayetteville, accepts yard waste to include small tree limbs, straw, leaves, hedge clippings and grass. There is no charge for yard debris, but there is a limit of four cubic yards per week. The cost for homeowners with large limbs (over 3 inches in diameter or 3 feet in length), small tree stumps, wooden pallets and clean scrap wood is \$1.85 per 100 pounds or \$37 per ton. The facility is open Monday through Saturday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Remember that large tree stumps, painted or treated wood, paneling, plywood and particle board must go to the Ann Street Landfill, located at 698 Ann St., Fayetteville.

The Wilkes Road Facility also sells mulch at the following prices:

- Rough Cut Mulch - \$10 per pickup truck load; larger vehicles \$5.50 per ton
- Screened/Fine - \$10 per pickup truck load; larger vehicles \$5 per cubic yard
- Red Mulch - \$60 per pickup truck load; larger vehicles \$30 per ton
