Oct. 10 Voter Registration Deadline, Poll Workers Needed

FAYETTEVILLE – The deadline to register for the November election or to change party affiliation to a current registration is **Oct. 10**. One-Stop Voting begins Oct. 23 and ends Nov. 1 at 1 p.m.

Voter registration is not conducted during One-Stop Voting. However, registered voters may update their address and change vital information, except party affiliation, at the One-Stop site.

The Board of Elections needs poll workers for the county's 77 voter precincts during the Nov. 4 General Election. There is a shortage of unaffiliated and registered Republican poll workers.

You must be a registered voter to work the polls and must attend a training session, which lasts about five hours. Poll workers are paid for attending training prior to the election and working on Election Day from 5:30 a.m. until all precincts have closed.

Anyone interested in serving as a poll worker should contact the Board of Elections, located at 227 Fountainhead Lane in the E. Newton Smith Center. Go to co.cumberland.nc.us/elections or call 910-678-7733. The website also offers information and links to voter information, a polling place finder and the N.C. Board of Elections.

One-Stop Voting will be held at the Board of Elections office Oct. 23, 24, 27 and 28 from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.; Oct. 29-31 from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m. and Nov. 1 from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

One-Stop Voting will be held at the following locations Oct. 23-Nov. 1, Monday through Friday, from 12 – 7 p.m. and Nov. 1 from 9 a.m. until 1 p.m.
