A large variety of plants will be available for purchase, including perennials, annuals, drought-tolerant plants, hard-to-find plants, plants to attract birds, bees and butterflies; herbs, vines, ground cover and more. Cash or checks will be accepted. Extension Master Gardener Volunteers will be available to advise buyers on purchases and to answer gardening questions.

Proceeds from the plant sale will be used for horticulture scholarships at Fayetteville Technical Community College, Cape Fear Botanical Garden, Master Gardener Demonstration Garden, Cumberland County Fair Youth Ag Day, Wounded Warrior Tranquility Garden, Second Harvest Food Bank Garden and educational programs in schools, clubs and libraries.
