Start Your Tax Preparations with your Library's Help

Free resources include a list of free or no-cost preparers, instruction books, and more

The Cumberland County Public Library & Information Center has collected the resources you need to get started with your 2014 tax return. The Library Resource Guide on taxes (available at <http://cumberland.lib.nc.libguides.com/taxes>) consolidates this information into an easy-to-access summary. The guide includes:

- Local organizations that provide low- or no-cost tax preparation services, including Consumer Credit Counseling of Fayetteville; CCAP, Inc.; the Fayetteville Senior Center; the State Employees' Credit Union; and the Fort Bragg Tax Center
- Books that can guide individuals through tax preparation for themselves, a business or a nonprofit organization
- Contact information for the local offices of the Internal Revenue Service and the North Carolina Department of Revenue
- Links to commonly used forms (note: the library is unable to provide printed tax

forms)
