Front Courthouse Parking Lot, Dick Street Closed July 10-12

FAYETTEVILLE – The front parking lot of the Cumberland County Courthouse and Dick Street between Russell Street and Otis Jones Parkway will be closed beginning at noon on Friday, July 10, and remain closed through Sunday, July 12. The parking lot and street will be closed to allow for the operation of a large crane that will be used to replace a 15,000-pound air conditioning chiller on the roof of the Law Enforcement Center, 131 Dick St.

Anyone who needs to visit the Courthouse or Law Enforcement Center (LEC) for business Friday afternoon is advised to use the Cool Spring Street parking lot or the lot behind First Presbyterian Church using the Person Street entrance.

The Courthouse front entrance and LEC lobby can be accessed through the side stairways and sidewalk from the rear Courthouse parking lot. The sheriff's watch commander and LEC lobby will be open for normal weekend hours.

Dick Street and the parking lot will be open for normal business Monday, July 13.
