Engineering & Infrastructure Director to Chair National Committee

FAYETTEVILLE – Cumberland County Engineering and Infrastructure Director Jeffery Brown has been appointed to serve as chair of the American Public Works Association Facilities and Grounds Technical Committee. The one-year chairmanship begins Aug. 30.

The Facilities and Grounds Committee serves as the APWA’s center of expertise for facilities management and grounds maintenance within public works. The committee meets monthly by conference call and twice per year in person. Brown was appointed chair because of his expertise in the subject matter areas assigned to the committee.

“It is a privilege and an honor to be asked to serve as the Committee Chair for the Facilities and Grounds Technical Committee over the next year as we work to provide technical guidance on key issues facing the organization’s membership,” Brown said.

Brown has been a member of the APWA for nine years and was first appointed a member of the Facilities and Grounds Committee in March 2014. Brown has been the County’s engineering and infrastructure director since April 2012. His professional experience includes eight years with the City of Fayetteville, during which time he served as an engineer II, city engineer, and the engineering and infrastructure director. Prior to working for the city, Brown spent five years with the N.C. Department of Environment and Natural Resources as an environmental engineer.
