## **Proposed South Central Land Use Plan Public Hearing June 15**

FAYETTEVILLE – The Cumberland County Board of Commissioners will hold a public hearing about the Proposed South Central Land Use Plan June 15 at 6:45 p.m. at their regular meeting in Room 118 of the Courthouse, 117 Dick St. Persons desiring to speak at the public hearing must register with the Clerk to the Board prior to commencement of the meeting or by calling 910-678-7771.

The purpose of the public hearing is to give residents an opportunity to present their comments and concerns about the plan. The Cumberland County Planning and Inspections Department staff encourages all interested parties to attend the hearing.

The Proposed South Central Land Use Plan is generally defined as south of the Crown Coliseum Complex and City of Fayetteville line; west of the Cape Fear River, east of Eastern Boulevard and north of the Bladen and Robeson County lines.
